Venerable Pierre Toussaint (1776-1853) was born a slave in Haiti. Brought to New York, he eventually went on to found one of New York’s first orphanages.

Mother Mary Elizabeth Lange (1784-1882) was the foundress and first Superior General of the Oblate Sisters of Providence, the first congregation of African American women religious in the history of the Catholic Church.

Venerable Henriette Delille (1813-1862) was born in New Orleans, where she lived all of her life. She was determined to help those in need for the love of Jesus and for the sake of the Gospel.

Fr. Augustus Tolton (1854-1897) was the first publically known African American Roman Catholic priest in the United States when he was ordained in 1886.
