DIG DEEPER! - For many of us, our Catholic education ended with our 8th grade confirmation, or as converts, once we were received into the Church. There is a "youth" version of the Catechism for young adult Catholics called YOUCAT. Please consider learning more about your faith from this rich Catholic resource.
