MISSION SUNDAY IS JULY 24. Please mark your calendars! Next Sunday is Mission Sunday. Holy Name welcomes Father Sergio Perez, who will be at each Mass to share with us his experiences as a missionary. Fr. Perez attended seminary in Argentina, was ordained a deacon in Rome, and then as a priest in Argentina. He was sent to Italy to finish his studies at the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome. After his studies he was assigned to South Sudan, and Kenya. Following his nine years in Africa he was sent to his current mission in Albania. He is a member of the Religious Institute, and on August 9th will celebrate his 15th anniversary as a priest.

Fr. Perez is firstly, asking for our prayers for the missions. He also asks that you consider financially supporting the work of missionaries throughout the world. There will be a **second collection** at each Mass **next Sunday**, which will be sent to the Mission Office of the Diocese for distribution. UNDERSTANDING THE MASS

THE LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

The Eucharistic Prayer – Last week we presented two parts of the Eucharistic Prayer, the Preface, and the Sanctus. The next part of the Eucharistic Prayer is the **Epiclesis**. *Epiclesis* is an ancient Greek word meaning "invocation" or "calling down from on high" by which the priest invokes the Holy Spirit (or the power of His blessing) upon the Eucharistic bread and wine. In this moment, the priest extends his hands and imposes them over the offerings. Just as the Holy Spirit descended over the Virgin Mary so that she would conceive and Jesus would be made present in her womb, now we invoke the Holy Spirit to descend over these gifts and make Christ present in our midst.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE NEW MASS SCHEDULE OF HOLY NAME PARISH AND PARROQUIA SANTA CRUZ

Several years ago the Diocese of Columbus created a long range planning committee to evaluate future parish requirements including manpower, finances, priest demographics and availability of potential priests.

The aging facilities, maintenance costs, and decline in church attendance has affected a number of our parishes in the Diocese. Last year our Diocese was in the red on their operating budget, and this has affected a number of smaller parishes. Holy Name parish has been declining in size and is one of the smallest parishes. Fortunately Santa Cruz, the Latino parish here at Holy Name, has been growing rapidly.

At a time when the Diocese is contemplating eliminating some parishes we have been asked to combine the pastoral work of both parishes. This includes the shared spaces of church, undercroft, and parking lot. I feel we are very fortunate to be able to continue to maintain both parishes under one roof.

After prayer and after consulting some other brother priests from Parishes that went through similar change, I met with a number of the Holy Name parishioners and explained a plan to better serve both parishes.

Considering the number of people attending Masses on Sunday which means between 900 and 1,000 people from Santa Cruz versus 200 people from Holy Name where almost 50% are transient students, based on logistics which include lack of space in the parking lot, the need of additional classrooms for Sunday religious education, I realize the impossibility to keep three morning Masses in the same Church. I am forced to make a change that will impact both parishes. From the first Sunday of August the 10:00 AM Mass will be discontinued. I am sorry for the inconvenience that the change will cause to some of our parishioners and I appreciate the openness and understanding of all. Listed below, you will find the new mass schedules for both parishes.

I ask for your continued prayers and support for both Parishes. Thank you, and may God bless you. *Fr. Antonio Carvalho*
