The Diocese of Columbus will be joining the Holy Father on March 4th and 5th, in an important initiative of prayer and reconciliation: **24 Hours With The Lord**. We will need people to prayerfully cover this 24 hr Adoration period, including throughout the night. You may spend your time with Our Lord in prayer, or in quiet spiritual reading. Ideally, each person can spend at least 1 hour with Our Lord, but we are grateful, and you will benefit from any time spent with Our Lord. The 24-hour Adoration schedule at Holy Name is as follows:

FRIDAY, MARCH 4

4:30 PM - Eucharistic Adoration begins.

5:30 PM Mass will be celebrated

6:00 PM Adoration resumes in the Chapel of St. Therese.

We will pray 3 rosaries with the Medjugorje prayer group at this time. Adoration to continue through the night till 8:30 AM

SATURDAY, MARCH 5

8:30 AM - Mass will be celebrated.

9:00 AM Adoration will resume with the praying of one rosary in Chapel of St. Therese.

6:00 PM Adoration will conclude with Benediction.

(Saturday morning there will be a youth rally in the basement of the church. It may get very noisy, but adoration will continue regardless)

SUPPORTING THE RICE BOWL - Step 1: Pick up your Rice Bowl from the Cathedral this Sunday; **Step 2:** Take your Rice Bowl home, assemble it as instructed, and begin filling it with your pocket change or other monetary donations; **Step 3:** Return your Rice Bowl with donations to Holy Name Church on Palm Sunday, March 20. *Ten dollars can be used to pay for two weeks of food for a family of six, or get a health exam for thirteen children. Fifteen dollars will supply a farmer with a year's worth of seeds. Fifty dollars will allow a village with five hundred families to receive clean water. With a hundred dollars, nurses can immunize over 150 newborn babies.*
