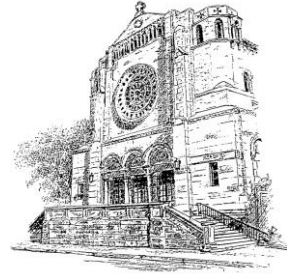

THE MONTH OF JANUARY is traditionally dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus. The Lord Jesus promised, “Whatever you ask in my name, I will do” (Jn 14:13). For “the name ‘Jesus’ contains all...His name is the only one that contains the presence it signifies” (CCC 2666). “You have had yourselves washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ” (1 Cor 6:11). For there is no “other name under heaven given to the human race by which we are to be saved” (Acts 4:12). We must live with special attentiveness to the Holy Name. It is the simplest yet most powerful prayer we could ever make, for that name means Savior. “If you think the name ‘Jesus’ continually, it purges your sin and kindles your heart; it clarifies your soul; it removes anger and does away with slowness. It wounds in love and fulfills charity. It chases the devil and puts out dread. It opens heaven, and makes you a contemplative.” (R.Rolle)
