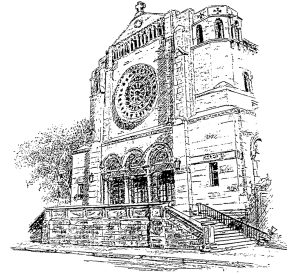

REVERENCE FOR OUR LORD IN THE MOST

BLESSED SACRAMENT - Please, as you enter the Church make the sign of the Cross. If you are physically able, kneel in humble and grateful silence, to worship and adore Our Lord, who is really, truly, substantially present in the Tabernacle. Take a moment to express your love for Him who loves you so dearly. Consider the great joy that Our Lord will have as He comes to your heart again during Holy Communion. Just as you would exert much effort to prepare your home to receive a guest, how much more should you prepare your heart and soul to receive your Lord and Savior in the most Holy Eucharist? If you are aware of grave or mortal sin, please out of respect for our dear Lord, do not present yourself for Communion. Choose instead to make a spiritual Communion. Take the first opportunity to go to reconciliation before receiving Him in Holy Communion. It is so important to prepare a fit, neat place to welcome Him in your heart and in your soul.

for our Eucharistic Lord.**

AN ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION - (When we cannot or should not receive Holy Eucharist) My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.



THE MONTH OF JULY IS DEDICATED TO THE PRECIOUS BLOOD.

The feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, and that the sacraments were brought forth through His Blood. *"The Precious Blood which we worship is the Blood which the Savior shed for us on Calvary and reassumed at His glorious Resurrection; it is the Blood which courses through the veins of His risen, glorified, living body at the right hand of God the Father in heaven; it is the Blood made present on our altars by the words of Consecration; it is the Blood which merited sanctifying grace for us and through it washes and beautifies our soul and inaugurates the beginning of eternal life in it."* (Pius IX)

Please also pray in thanksgiving to those who serve and support others at this time.
