During the Fortnight, our liturgical calendar celebrates a series of great martyrs who remained faithful in the face of persecution by political power – St. John the Baptist, SS. Peter and Paul, the First Martyrs of the Church of Rome, St. John Fisher, and St. Thomas More. Through prayer, study, and peaceful public action during the Fortnight for Freedom, we hope to remind everyone throughout the United States of the importance of preserving the fundamental right of religious freedom. Consider spending an extra hour in Adoration during the Fortnight to pray for religious liberty. Additionally, a special Mass and Holy Hour for Religious Freedom will be celebrated on **Wednesday, June 28, at 5:15 p.m.**, at Saint Joseph Cathedral, 212 East Broad Street.
