Take a moment to express your love for Him who loves you so dearly. Consider the great joy that Our Lord will have as He comes to your heart again during Holy Communion. Just as you would exert much effort to prepare your home to receive a guest, how much more should you prepare your heart and soul to receive your Lord and Savior in the most Holy Eucharist? If you are aware of grave or mortal sin, please out of respect for our dear Lord, do not present yourself for Communion. Choose instead to make a spiritual Communion. Take the first opportunity to go to reconciliation before receiving Him in Holy Communion. It is so important to prepare a fit, neat place to welcome Him in your heart and in your soul.*

**May God grant us a renewed reverence and love for our Eucharistic Lord.**

**AN ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION** - *(When we cannot or should not receive Holy Eucharist) My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.*
