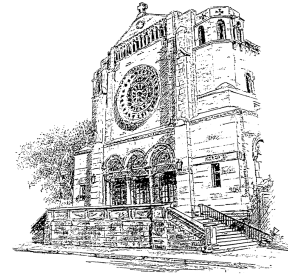

**THE MAN OF THE SHROUD** – A traveling exhibit on the Shroud of Turin, including a full scale linen replica of the Shroud, will be presented for five days at SS, Simon and Jude Catholic Church, 9350 High Free Pike, West Jefferson, OH. (corner of I-70 and St. Rte. 142) Saturday, June 15 – Wednesday, June 18, 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM daily. This exhibit is open to the public at no cost. Venerated and believed by many to be the burial cloth of Jesus of Nazareth, this exhibit examines the scriptural, historical, and scientific evidence of one of the most studied religious icons in history. There will also be a special presentation on the Shroud's history by Mr. Tony Stout, a member of St. Cecilia Parish, at 5 PM Saturday, June 15. *(While the Catholic Church does not take an official stance on the Shroud's authenticity, it does say it is an object worthy of veneration.)*
