### LENTEN REFLECTION: ST. JOSEPH

Today is the feast day of St. Joseph, Husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary. There are no recorded words of St. Joseph in the Bible, but in his silence he spoke volumes. In 2005, Joseph Ratzinger (Pope Benedict XVI), spoke some inspiring words concerning the silence of his namesake "His is a silence permeated by contemplation of the mystery of God, in an attitude of total availability to his divine wishes. Let us allow ourselves to be "infected" by the silence of St Joseph! We have much need of it in a world which is often too noisy, which does not encourage reflection and listening to the voice of God." (Pope Benedict XVI, December 18, 2005)
