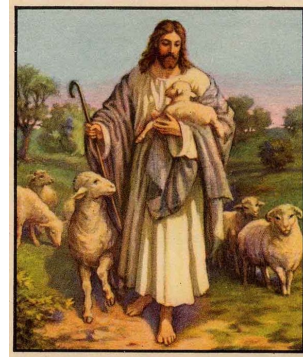
PRAY THE ROSARY FOR AN END TO COVID 19!
