

### PSALMS

**THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER** is dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory. The soul of a person who dies goes to one of three places. The first is heaven, where a person goes who dies in a state of perfect grace and communion with God. The second is hell, where those who die in a state of mortal sin are, by choice, condemned eternally. The intermediate state is purgatory, where those free of mortal sin, but still in a state of lesser (venial) sin, must go. Nothing unclean can enter heaven. Purgatory is necessary so that souls can be cleansed and perfected before they enter into heaven. Consistent with these teachings and traditions, Catholics believe that through the prayers of the faithful on Earth, and in heaven, the dead are cleansed of their sins so they may enter into heaven.

**A partial indulgence** can be obtained by devoutly visiting a cemetery and praying for the departed. A partial indulgence, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, can also be obtained when the Eternal Rest (*Requiem aeternam*) is prayed.

*Eternal rest grant to them, O Lord,  
and let perpetual light shine upon them.*

*May the souls of the faithful departed,  
through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.*

**A plenary indulgence** can be obtained by visiting a cemetery each day between November 1, and November 8. These indulgences are applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory. A plenary indulgence, is also granted when the faithful piously visit a church or a public oratory on November 2. In visiting the church or oratory, it is required, that one *Our Father* and the *Credo* be recited.
