OCTOBER IS RESPECT LIFE MONTH – This is also the year of St. Joseph, as declared by Pope Francis. Turn to St. Joseph as he is a beautiful example of the faithful protector of both Jesus and Mary. In St. Joseph we find a profound reminder of our own call to welcome, safeguard, and defend God’s precious gift of human life. *Please pray for the protection of all human life from conception to natural death.*

PRAY FOR DOBBS - Earlier this year, the United States Supreme Court agreed to take up *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*. The case addresses the constitutionality of a 15-week abortion ban passed into law in Mississippi, and it has the potential to overturn *Roe v. Wade*. Oral arguments will be held December 1, and a decision is expected in June 2022. Because of this, *Pray for Dobbs* ecumenical prayer campaign emerged. National faith leaders from varying Christian denominations, and our own Archbishop Naumann, are calling people of faith nationwide and across denominations to unite in prayer and fasting. A simple website is in development to serve as the touchpoint for all the denominational partners: prayfordobbs.com. Also planned is a **(Virtual) National Prayer Event: Thursday, November 18 at 8 PM (EST)** Join Catholics and other Christians from across the country uniting in prayer. Additional information will be shared as it becomes available.
